SINGLE STREAM RESIDENTIAL RECYCLE



Recycling is mandatory in Harvey County

- * Pick-up is every other Friday (see calendar on reverse side)
- * Cost is \$4.25 per month (includes 1 cart)
- * **Items to be recycled in cart provided are:**
 - Glass food & beverage jars & bottles (all colors)
 - Aluminum & steel (beverage & food cans)
 - Aluminum Foil, clean
 - Empty aerosol cans
 - Plastic beverage, food & soap containers #1 thru #7
 - Magazines, newspapers (with inserts), junk mail, office paper, phone books, catalogs, other light colored paper
 - Corrugated Cardboard (cut, flattened and placed in cart)
 - Chip Board (cereal, shoe boxes, etc.)
- * **Outside of cart:**
 - Used Waste Oil in sealed container & labeled "Waste Oil"



UNACCEPTED MATERIALS

- Plastic Grocery or Trash Bags
- Styrofoam
- Electronics
- Ceramics or Dishes
- Food Waste
- Motor Oil Containers
- Household Hazardous Waste
- Yard Waste or Trash
- Shredded Paper
- Light Bulbs, Window Glass, or Mirrors

RECYCLE TIPS

- All items should be placed loose in cart. No plastic bags.
- Rinse all cans, bottles, and glass of foodstuffs before placing in recycle cart.
- Can lids should be placed inside cans, with top of can slightly flattened.
- Labels do not need to be removed from any recycle items.
- Paper towels and napkins should be placed with regular trash.

TRASH

- * Pick-up is every Friday except:
 - Fri., Jan. 1, will be Sat., Jan 2, 2016
 - Fri., Nov. 25, will be Sat., Nov. 26, 2016
 - Fri., Dec. 30, will be Sat., Dec. 31, 2016
- * Cost is \$11.50 per month for basic service which includes 1 cart
- * \$1.00 per each additional cart
- * Citizens 65 & older qualify for Senior Rate \$9.50

YARD WASTE

CANNOT be included with regular trash



- * The City will provide curbside pickup of yard waste twice annually:
 - May 31 & November 28, 2016
- * Yard waste is limited to grass, leaves, limbs, branches, garden debris (excluding produce)
- * Yard waste may be taken to the City Burnsight (no fee is charged) or to Harvey County Landfill
- * City Burnsight is open every Saturday, 9 AM to 1 PM

HAZARDOUS WASTE

needs to be taken to Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility, 3205 SW 24th, Newton, KS (on the south side of road just west of Cow Palace Rd, 1 mile south of US HWY 50). Items they will take are paints & paint-related products, pesticides, household products containing organic solvents, ignitables, & aerosols. Their hours of operation are Mon. - Fri., 8 am to 4:45 pm. For more information or to make an appointment, call 316-283-5439. A pamphlet containing more detailed information about hazardous waste is available from the City Clerk's office.

CART PLACEMENT

- Carts must be placed curbside by 6 am on pickup day.
- Within 2 feet from the curb
- Handle side away from the street
- 3 feet away from other objects (including other carts)
- 6 feet away from vehicles
