2014 Discover Halstead Incentive Plan

- I. **Purpose:** The 2014 Discover Halstead Incentive Plan is intended to promote the overall development of City of Halstead, KS (the "City"), USD 440 Halstead Bentley (the "school") and the Halstead Chamber of Commerce (the "chamber") by stimulating growth of new families.
- II. **Operation of the Housing Incentive Plan:** The governing bodies of the City, School, and Chamber have approved the payments of the Incentive Plan (the "Plan") to Qualified Applicants. Applications for incentives are to be made during the Application Period to the Halstead Chamber of Commerce Oversight Committee and are to be made during the Application Period using the form attached referred hereto as "Exhibit B". Upon approval of such application by the Oversight Committee the Qualified Applicant will receive the plan Incentive outlined in The Incentive Plan referred hereto as "Exhibit A".

At the end of the Application Period, the governing bodies of the City, School, and Chamber will review the Plan and determine its continuation.

- III. **Definitions:** As used in this Plan, the following terms have the following respective meanings:
 - a. **Application Period** – means the period beginning March 1st 2103 and ending December 31st, 2013.
 - b. **Incentive** – means a payment of Halstead Chamber of Commerce chamber bucks to the Qualified Applicant set for in the Plan. Incentive amount will be determined in accordance with the chart set forth on Exhibit A
 - c. **Plan** – shall mean the Discover Halstead Incentive Plan approved by the governing bodies of the City, School, and Chamber.
 - d. **Qualified Applicant** – means a person that has made application during the application period and meets the criteria set in the Plan
 - e. **New Resident** – mean a person that has established a new primary residence in their name for the last 90 days and formerly lived outside of the City limits for the previous 90 days.
 - f. **New Employee** – means a person that has established new full time employment with a member of the Halstead KS Chamber of Commerce, and formerly held full time employment with a non Halstead KS Chamber of Commerce member for the previous 90 days.
 - g. **New Student** – means a family or guardian that is enrolling their first child into the USD 440 school district and that child has remained enrolled for 90 days and who was previous enrolled for 90 days in another district.
- IV. **Additional Criteria for Determining Eligibility**
 - a. New resident must be current on all bills owed to the City and still residing in the City at the time of application.
 - b. New Employ must be still employed full time with the qualified chamber member at the time of application.

- c. New Student must still be enrolled at USD 440 at the time of application and current on all fees.
- d. New employee that has previous been on unemployment benefits for 90 days will be eligible for the incentive.
- e. New student of a family or guardian who did not have school aged children in the previous 90 days will be eligible for the incentive.
